

## WOOD

- Use a solution of mild soap and warm water for daily cleaning.
- Avoid abrasive soaps or cleansers.
- Spray soap solution and wipe clean with a cloth.
- Always wipe up moisture promptly and dry with a soft cloth.
- Wood will expand and contract with seasonal humidity changes.  
Maintain consistent humidity levels to minimize changes in the wood and prevent warping.

## POWDERCOAT

- Use a solution of mild soap and warm water for daily cleaning.
- Avoid abrasive soaps or cleansers.
- Use a damp cloth to clean as needed, wipe dry.
- Do not use cleaning products containing ammonia, alcohol or petroleum.

## CONCRETE

- Use a solution of mild soap and warm water for daily cleaning.
- Avoid abrasive soaps or cleansers.
- Do not cut directly on concrete top to avoid damaging the sealer.
- Avoid placing hot items directly on the concrete top.  
Concrete is heat resistant, but excessive heat can damage or discolor the sealer.
